Whereas the lack of available health care is a barrier to opportunity, success and quality of life; and

Whereas Oregonians should not be divided between those who can afford to be healthy and those who cannot; and

Whereas Oregonians should not be divided between those who have
hopes and dreams and those whose sickness, disease, or injury rob them
of their hopes and dreams; now therefore be it resolved by
that:

The Constitution of the State of Oregon shall be amended by creating a new section 46 to be added and made a part of Article 1, such section to read:

Section 46. It is the obligation of the state to establish a single system that would ensure that every person in Oregon has access to equal, effective, comprehensive, medically necessary, and affordable health care, as a fundamental human right.
